


# Playground – Tree guard














Playground – Mural





#### Treasurer's Report

Areti and Ruth are still the only members of the PC able to access online banking just now, but I am now a signatory and we are continuing to chase for the online access for me as well which will help with processing expenses and invoices in the future.

The accounts have been examined and approved by Victoria, and can now be published on the website for transparency.

The bank balance was £15,790.13 as of 03 November 2023. Since the last meeting we have raised £170 from the Halloween Trail and £382 from the Bake Sale. We have bought the new library books for the library for £1,000, and the remaining funding requests previously agreed in June 2023 for library software (£499.99) and chess tournament entries (£150) are yet to be invoiced for payment totalling £649.99.


The funding requests for Prefect bibs (£200), Sports Tops (£160), Wooden Blocks (£1,110 + £222 VAT )and Football Kits (£362) approved at the AGM in September are also yet to be invoiced totalling £1,832 (or £2,054 if VAT to be paid).

Taking these into account, this brings the balance available to approximately £13,000 to support any further funding requests.
